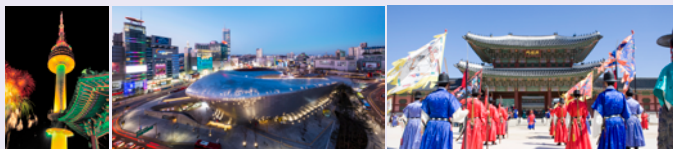
AYEA 2017 PROGRAM
